What's New?

Our 3-D digital scanner is what's new! In May 2021, Dr. Johnson implemented a digital scanner into the practice. Gaggers Rejoice- no more goop! The Trios scanner replaces the conventional use of dental impression. It creates a live 3-D model of your teeth. We use the scanner when we prep crowns, design smile make-overs, or for clear aligners. We've found that the precision of the scanner reduces the amount of adjusting needed on new crowns and the crowns come back from the lab much quicker. Dr. Johnson maintains the importance of staying current with the latest dental technologies.

Dr. Johnson became a Clinical Consultant for Dental Advisor in 2020. Dental Advisor is a company that provides information to dentists on new dental products and equipment coming to market. “Hey doc, Can you fix my Snaggle Tooth?”*

While the primary focus of our office is health and function, esthetics are certainly important. One of the reasons Dr. Johnson likes dentistry is that it blends function and esthetics. He and the staff enjoy doing cosmetic work and find these procedures to be fun and rewarding. If you are displeased with the appearance of your teeth and/or would like a change, please bring it up at your next appointment. Below are some in-office examples of what is possible to improve your smile.



This patient's front tooth no longer matched its neighboring teeth. Previous trauma had caused the tooth to darken from the inside over the past several years. The best treatment was determined to be a ceramic veneer. The tooth is lightly prepped on the front edge and a custom shade veneer was made to create an ideal shade match.



After being unhappy with her front teeth for years, this patient was ready for a change. The patient completed in-office whitening to brighten her teeth. After, Dr. Johnson crowned her front six teeth on the top arch to achieve a new improved appearance that is natural and bright.



Although this composite filling was structurally sound, the appearance was unsatisfactory. The discolored filling made the front tooth look dingy. The filling was switched out to a newer material that matched the rest of the tooth.



Called a peg lateral, this relatively common congenital malformation may be considered unattractive. Without drilling, filling material was bonded to the tooth. The bonding was formed to create a more ideal shape and match the corresponding tooth on the side of the arch.
